1- It stands above every other book.

2- We have an English Bible in our possession largely because of John Wycliffe.

The John Wycliffe Bible of 1382 marks was the first complete translation of the Bible into English. The English Bible can be found worldwide today.

3- Fidel Castro, when taking over Cuba, took a shipload of Bibles, had them processed back into paper pulp and had communist literature printed on them.

But that has not destroyed the Bible in Cuba, for it still survives.

IV. CONSIDER THE WONDER OF ITS PRESENTATION. John 5:39

1- The Bible presents a message of salvation through Jesus to those who are deserving of nothing but hell.

2- It tells us of the great love the Lord has for us, and His desire for us to be saved.

3- God has written a book to tell us how much he loves us!
