II Corinthians 13:5 NLT – The Message

This passage calls for self-examination.

- 1. It has been said that "I" is the most important and influential letter in the alphabet. "I" is the person responsible for your every action.
- 2. Something else we should recognize about "I"!

"I" is in the center of sin, pride, and Saviour.

I. "I" IS THE CENTER OF SIN

- 1. Sin is the transgression of God's law.
- 2. Sin is what defiles us. Mark 7: 20-23
- 3. Sin separates from God. Isa 59:2
- 4. Sin excludes from Heaven I Corinthians 6:9-11
- 5. Sin is forgivable **Ephesians 1:6, 7**

The blood of Christ takes "I" out of sin...

II. "I" IS THE CENTER OF PRIDE Luke 18:11-14

- 1. The Pharisee's greatest sin was pride, -- "I"
- 2. Pride goes before destruction, and haughtiness before a fall. Proverbs 16:18
- 3. Pharaoh's pride destroyed him. Exodus 5
- 4. Naaman's pride almost cost him his life. II kings.5
- 5. Pride destroys humility and builds a wall between us and God.

III. "I" IS THE CENTER OF SAVIOUIR

- 1. John 14:15-20
- 2. So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. Romans 8:1
- 3. In Christ you are a new creature. Galatians 2:20
- 4. Our faith and hope, our comfort and strength, and our joy are found in Him.
- 5. For in him we live and move and exist. As some of your own poets have said, 'We are his offspring.' Acts 17:28
