I. WHAT HAVE I DONE WITH GOD?

The Creator and Sustainer of my life.

Genesis 2:7; 1 Samuel 2:6

II WHAT HAVE I DONE WITH CHRIST?

Have I received Him or rejected Him?

Is His blood sprinkled **ON MY HEART** or **UNDER MY FEET**?

III. WHAT HAVE I DONE WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT?

Have I HARDENED MY HEART TO HIM?

Have I received Him in all His fullness, or am I guilty of grieving Him?

Ephesians 4:30

IV. WHAT HAVE I DONE WITH MY BIBLE?

Have I been reading it as Gods written message to my soul?

Have I been declaring its truth or am I ashamed of it?

2 Timothy 2:15

V. WHAT HAVE I DONE WITH MY OPPORTUNITIES?

Have I taken advantage of my God-given privileges?

Privileges to: a. hear His word, (heartfully)

b. speak in His name (on His behalf)

VI. WHAT HAVE I DONE WITH MY NEIGHBOURS?

Have I treated them as inferior to me, or

Have I loved them as I love myself?

Have I received the Grace of God, and then

Treated them as if I owed them nothing?

VII. WHAT HAVE I DONE WITH THE INNER CRY OF MY OWN NEED?

Have I been conscious of the <u>need of God's forgiveness</u> and <u>deliverance</u> from <u>the power of sin</u>,

But sought to stop the voice of the Spirit within?

Have I sought COMFORT Instead of CONFESSION?

Am I one of those of whom the Lord complains,

They do not repent saying, What a terrible thing I have done!
