Happy Mother's Day Luke 1:26-37

Being a mother today is a tough job & we recognize that.

But as hard as it is we need to realize that <u>difficulties are not unique to our time</u>.

Consider Mary, the mother of Jesus.

I. THE DIFFICULTIES MARY FACED

A. First of all, she faced the difficulty of a tarnished reputation.

Mary was pregnant out of wedlock. [Now, we know the rest of the story]!

B. Secondly, Mary experienced the difficulty of poverty.

When Jesus was brought to the Temple as a baby for the first time,

Joseph & Mary offered 2 doves, the sacrifice of the very poorest in society.

C. Another difficulty Mary experienced was being a single mom.

The last time Joseph is mentioned was when Jesus was 12 years old.

II. THE RESOURCES MARY HAD

A. Her first resource was a strong commitment to doing God's will.

Luke 1:30 - Luke 1:46, 47 - Acts 1:14 - Luke 1:35-38

Mary knew that by giving birth to Jesus she was doing what God commissioned her to do.

B. Her Second resource was a supportive husband.

Matthew 1:24

C. A third resource was a close friend who encouraged her.

Luke 1:42

Mary and Elizabeth spent about 6 months together - encouraging one another.

Hebrews 3:13

We need to encourage moms today & help them realize they're doing a job no one else can do.

III. THE REWARDS MARY EXPERIENCED

Mary was rewarded for her faithfulness as a mother.

And the God who rewarded her has promised to reward us, too.

IV. HERE'S THE GOOD NEWS:
