While salvation is the gift of God, at Christ's expense ---

<u>Discipleship is costly!</u> It is achieved at great cost!

I. AM I CHRIST'S DISCIPLE? John 8:31-32

A. Disciples must pay the price to qualify: Luke 14:25-27

Jesus called Peter, Andrew, James and John.

It took courage, faith and love to move beyond simple belief.

- B. His words are the supreme test.
 - 1. He warns those who obey in word but not in action. Matt. 7:21-23
 - 2. So true discipleship goes beyond belief to action.

It is not merely hearing the words of the Lord,

but it is doing something about what you hear and claim to believe.

- C. What is involved in becoming a disciple? In "going beyond belief"?
 - 1. First study the Holy Word. II Tim. 2:15 Amplified Bible
 - 2. Pray often and long.

Don't attempt to do the Master's work without His instruction.

3. Make sure that you are ready to commit.

Count the cost! **Proverbs 20:25**

4. GO!!
