WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE 1 John 5:12, 13

I. THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN HOPE AND NO HOPE.

1. The biblical definition of hope is "confident expectation."

Hope is a firm assurance regarding things that are unclear and unknown. Biblical **hope** has as its foundation faith in God. 1 **Thessalonians 4:13**

- 2. Concern about loved ones who die.
 - a. But we need not grieve like people who have no hope.
- 3. The Christian's grief is different.
 - a. We have assurance of better things ahead. Philippians 1:21-23
 - b. We know where the departed believers have gone. 2 Corinthians 5:8
 - c. We know we will see them again. 1 Thessalonians 4:17
- 4. Lost people have no hope!!!

II. THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN BELIEF AND UNBELIEF. 1 Thessalonians 4:14

- 1. The Key to Hope is Faith!
 - a. To believe is to trust.
 - b. More than intellectual assent.
 - c. Resting securely in Christ who died and rose again.
- 2. To believe is to be saved. Acts 16:31
- 3. To believe is to be sure of heaven. 1 John 5:12, 13
- 4. Concerning those who refuse to believe =

 They have no hope of heaven and will be forever lost.

III. THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN A BELIVERS DEATH

AND AN UNBELIVERS DEATH

1. At the death of a believer, their disembodied spirit = immediately enters the joyful presence of our Lord Jesus.

Luke 23:43: 2 Corinthians 5:8

2. At the death of an unbeliever, their disembodied spirit=
immediately enters the place of the dead, a place of torment. Luke 16:22b, 23

IV. THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE FIRST AND SECOND RESURRECTIONS.

PP17 1 Thessalonians 4:16

- 1. At the rapture, the believers spirit is joined with their resurrected body.
- 2. Living believers are caught up and changed. 1 Corinthians 15:51, 52
- 3. The unbelieving dead are resurrected later.

They are resurrected to Judgment. Revelation 20:5-15.

 - 2. Receive Him by faith and be ready for heaven and His return.
