Encouragement:

A. **Be encouraged** B. **Take courage** C. **Don't be afraid** D. **Take heart**, E. **Cheer up**, F. **Be Happy**
Jesus was serious about it!

Jesus is saying, "BE HAPPY!" We saw that it is in the imperative mood.

That means it is a command of God to be happy.

I. BE ENCOURAGED BECAUSE WE HAVE BEEN PARDONED!!

Romans 5:11

II. BE ENCOURAGED BECAUSE WE HAVE HIS POWER

Power over weakness - Yes, But much more important to us is HIS KEEPING POWER!

John 10:27-30 Amplified

III. BE ENCOURAGED BECAUSE WE HAVE HIS PRESENCE

Psa. 16:11 NLT

IV. BE ENCOURAGED BECAUSE WE HAVE HIS PEACE

John 16:33 NLT

What does possessing His peace entail?

Romans 5:1 NLT - Peace with God

Philippians 4:4-7 NLT - Peace of God

Isaiah 26:3 NLT - Perfect peace

V. BE ENCOURAGED BECAUSE WE HAVE HIS PROMISE

Acts 23:11 NLT

He has never failed on one promise.

I Kings 8:56 NLT

There is one more BE ENCOURAGED in the New Testament to consider.

It is given by man and not by the Lord.

Mark 10:48, 49 NLT

Blind Bartimaeus calls on the Lord for mercy. Jesus responds to his call for help.

So they called the blind man. "Cheer up," they said. "Come on, he's calling you!"

Be happy - There is a message to give and a message to receive.

What blocks the joy of the Lord in the lives of God's people?

1. Satan is against it. **1 Peter 5:8 NLT**

2. Sin blocks the joy of the Lord. **Psa.51:12 NLT** .

3. A lack of faith hinders joy. **Heb.11:6 NLT**

4. Prayerlessness **Phil.4:4-7 NLT**
